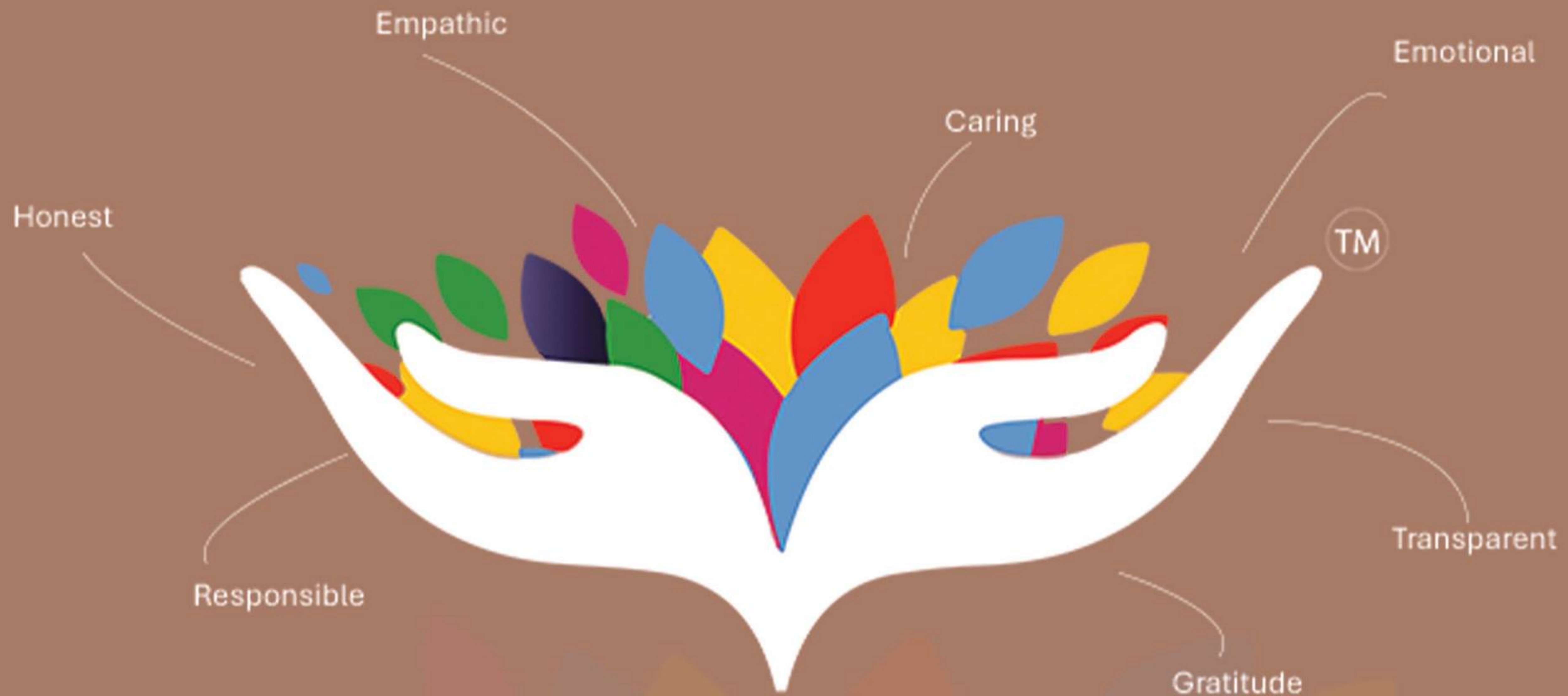

Key Focus Projects (2024-2025)

PROJECT *educate*

We believe there is no age limit for teaching or learning. Each one of us can educate so many people around us. Learning isn't restricted only to educational institutions; we can start wherever we are just with the willingness to impart knowledge. Volunteers help with educational supplies, school admissions and fees or help with studies. This initiative is not only for school & college students but also for adult education. Currently, we are setting up Computer learning centre (CLCs) in schools of Uttarakhand with a line up volunteer teachers who will conduct free online classes to underprivileged children.



PROJECT *pro*

Under this project our highly skilled professional volunteers with expertise in various backgrounds and from different parts of the world, are contributing by imparting knowledge remotely through online sessions and workshops to help individuals who are facing professional challenges to upgrade their skills.



Under **PROJECT *pro*** we are committed to help underprivileged with best of our knowledge.

PROJECT *life*

This project was initially built for helping the marching migrants during Covid19 pandemic with sanitary pads, face masks, sanitizers & basic medical help. During lockdown 1 we were able to help over 20,000 migrants on Delhi NCR highways. We helped 213 migrants reach their homes safely, In lockdown 2 we saved almost 630 lives through hospital admissions, ICU beds, oxygen cylinders, oxygen concentrators, plasma, blood, platelets, medicines & many more.



At **PROJECT *life*** we are currently helping in Dengue emergency with platelets & other medical assistance.

Currently, we're setting up Project Educate Centre in low-grade communities & upgrading small schools, making computer labs & connecting online volunteer teachers who conduct free online classes to underprivileged children pan-India. We have 51 centers running pan-India. We provide sponsorship to scholar kids, laptops for education, and study material if needed.

Volunteer Power. Empowering Lives



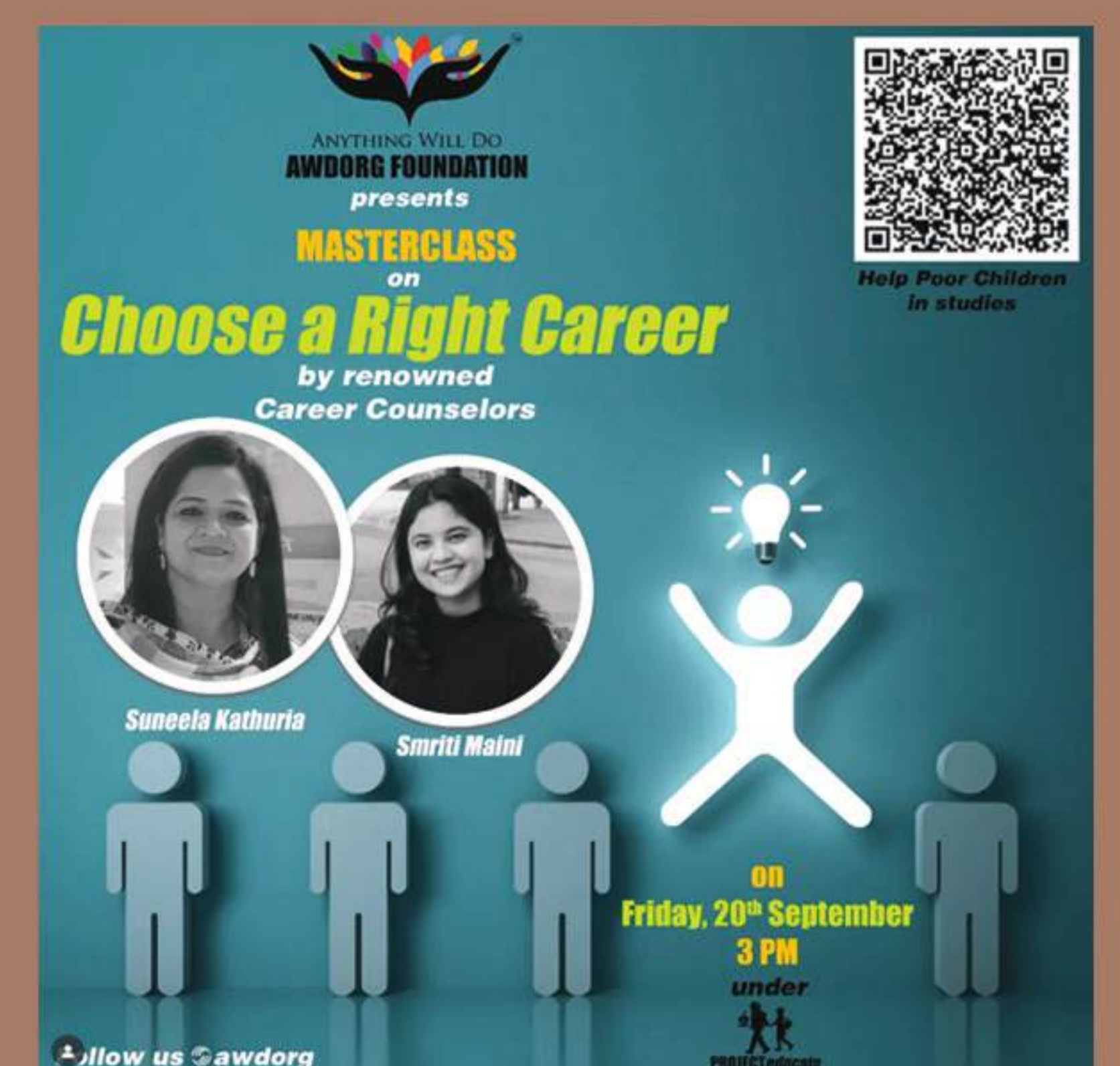

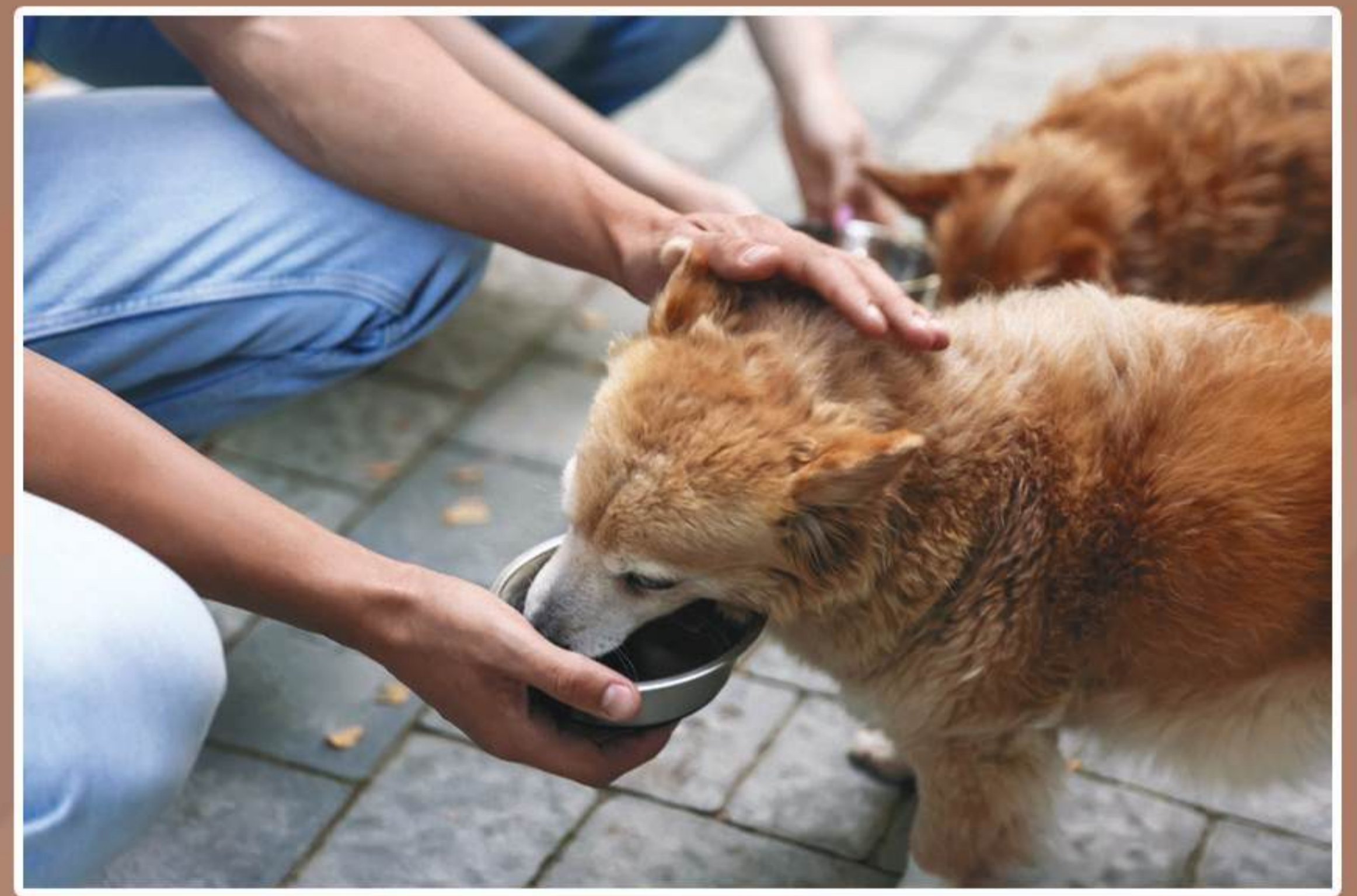


"Animals Do Speak, But The Question Is - Can We Hear Them?"

Many stray dogs and other animals have been fed and their emergency medical needs taken care of under this project. We carry hygienic food and clean water for these animals and drive around the city to feed them. We place earthen bowls filled with water for these animals on the streets. We have collaborated with FMCG companies for providing grinded material like biscuit crumbs which are left behind in excess during packaging. We pick up the same from the factories and mix it with milk or curd and feed the animals. Large number of packets of bread is also used as food for the animals on a daily basis. We run vaccinations & medical camps for strays regularly.

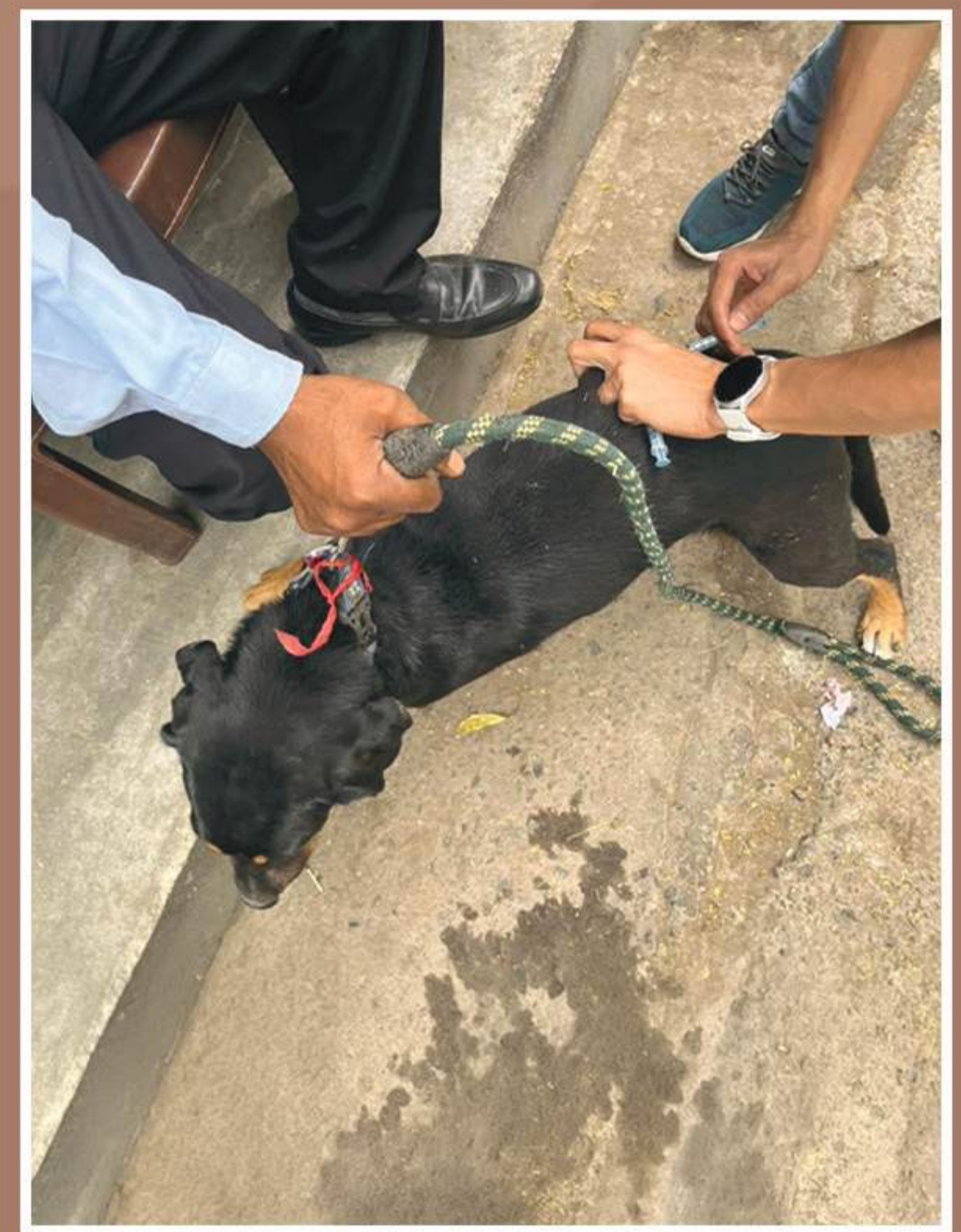
